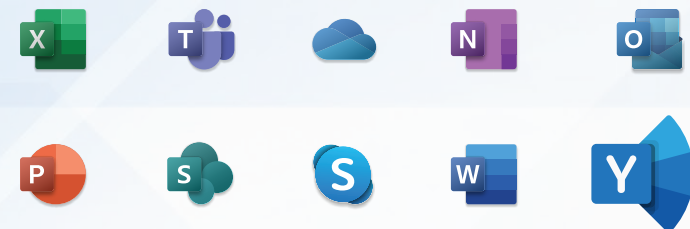

Microsoft's Enrollment for Education Solutions is an easy, cost-effective offer that provides qualified academic users with a simplified way to acquire Microsoft software and services under a subscription enrollment.



Overview

Enrollment for Education Solutions provides access to the suite of Microsoft products and services that can help educators expand their effectiveness in educating students and supporting faculty and staff.

By counting only the users (known as "Education Qualified Users") that need full access to these products, Boards can accurately license faculty, staff, and volunteers for the full suite of Microsoft products they need.

This product provides free access to Office 365 A1, plus the ability to subscribe to additional Microsoft cloud services or on premises products as needed, allowing flexibility in how academic providers and organizations supply the products their users need.

EES also provides productivity tools and benefits that help students and faculty interact and innovate with each other and those beyond the classroom environment.

Benefits

Enterprise Platform Products are licensed per user, making it easy to account for your Education Qualified Users and ensure they get the coverage they need, and nothing they don't.

It allows administrators to easily add licenses for additional products organization-wide, department-wide, or for individual licenses during subscription terms.

Subscription and per user licensing eliminates the need to track licenses for the selected Education Platform Products on every device, which helps IT staff to be more productive because they no longer have to track multiple licenses across the organization.

When licensing certain products organization-wide, users also qualify for corresponding subscription licenses for a number of students at no additional cost.

The ECNO EES Licensing agreement offers

- Common transaction vehicle for all eligible publicly funded school Boards in Ontario.
- Common negotiated terms applicable to all school Boards.
- Equitable pricing for all, regardless of school Board size.
- Lowers the EES entry minimum from 1,000 to 100 users.
- Level D pricing for all Boards, regardless of EQU count.

The current ECNO Enrollment for Education Solutions (EES) agreement provides Microsoft subscription licensing for education institutions over a 3-year term (November 1, 2023, to October 31, 2026), with the option to extend for a single three (3) year period.
