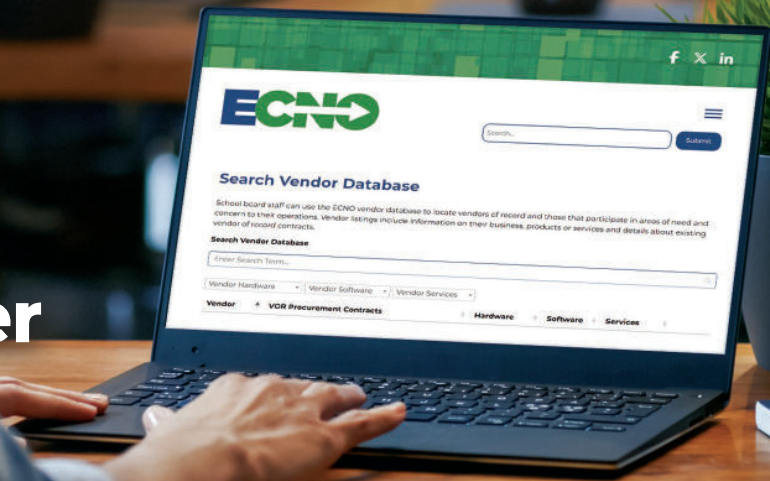


Join the ECNO Vendor Subscriber Database



ECNO is pleased to announce the Vendor Subscriber Database, a custom search engine through ecno.org for purchasing agents at Ontario School Boards to find professional vendors in the Ontario K-12 education technology space.

The database will allow buyers to search for a particular vendor, VOR procurement contract, or find vendors within categories and product types such as Hardware > Laptop Computers or Software > Cloud Apps (as examples).

Completed profiles will resemble this fictitious example —>>>>

ECNO welcomes K-12 marketplace vendors who share a commitment to promote savings, efficiencies, and collaboration within Ontario education. ECNO Vendor Subscribers should be willing to pay an annual Vendor Subscriber participant fee. The cost for becoming an ECNO Vendor Subscriber is tiered to reflect the varying needs of vendors:



- **Tier I** – ECNO Vendor Subscribers receive this listing page on the ECNO vendor database website, ensuring visibility to K-12 school board members. **\$2,500/year**, or;
- **Tier II** – Tier I privileges plus access to ECNO's own EdTech K-12 marketplace Primer documents and consultations with ECNO staff to help you navigate the K-12 system. **\$3,500/year**

School Board members have informed ECNO of their expectations regarding ethical and collaborative vendor behaviour. ECNO Vendor Subscribers agree to abide by the full [ECNO Vendor Code of Conduct](#) which reflects these expectations. Please review the Code before proceeding.

We invite you to participate in this highly anticipated program before we launch the database on November 4, 2024.

Here's how it works:

Step 1: Vendors complete and submit the Vendor Subscriber Profile with ECNO

Your profile is a high-level snapshot of your business. You will provide your company name, logo, featured product or service categories, current procurement contracts with related bodies such as OEM, and a URL link to your company's web page for Ontario K-12 education buyers. (see below for more information). Be sure to carefully review your information before you submit.

Important note: This is meant to be information that remains relatively static throughout the year. More detailed and ongoing information such as events, training, development, certification and promotions should be provided to school board members on *a separate external page hosted on your company's website*. You will be required to include a link to this page in your profile. Do not make this a generic home page, but a specific page with content that is geared to the Ontario K-12 education sector buyer only.

Step 2: You will receive an email confirmation which includes all of the information you provided on the intake form. If there are errors or discrepancies, **do not redo the form**. We'll be in touch and there will be an opportunity to provide corrections.

Step 3: ECNO will review your submission and will follow up to confirm if all is in good order or if we have comments or questions. We will confirm if you are an ECNO vendor in good standing, and if payment is required. If the latter, we will inquire as to whether you wish to be a Tier I or Tier II ECNO Vendor Subscriber.

Step 4: If payment is required, we will issue you an invoice. Terms are net 30.

Important note: The ECNO Vendor Subscriber Database will be launched on Monday, November 4, 2024. **No profiles will be published before the launch date.**

Step 5: We will publish your profile upon receipt of payment or on November 4, 2024, whichever is later. We will confirm with you that your profile has been published.

Please note that all profiles will be reviewed, and payments renewed, on an annual basis.
